Online Class Listing Tables are highly customizable, allowing you to showcase your class offerings by grouping classes, adding specific class information, hiding columns of information, and more!

It all starts with the basic Online Class Listing Table. There are 12 columns included in the basic table: Register, Class, Description, Days, Times, Gender, Ages, Openings, Class Starts, Class Ends, Session, and Tuition.

This column order is set (hardcoded), and columns cannot be moved to a different order; however, it is possible to hide any of the columns in a table. For example, hide the Openings column or the Session column.

To hide columns from Online Class Listing Tables, a parameter is added to the basic JavaScript code and URL (link). Well, that certainly sounds very techie [], doesn't it? It sounds worse than it is, we promise!
